Programmes are curated by older members of our Elders Theatre Company, members of Meet Me at the Albany and our artists in care homes programme Walking through Walls. Tea Dances have been nurturing new and distinctive performance through collaborations between older participants and visiting artists.

For the festival edition we will taking over the whole of the Albany theatre from **2pm-7pm on the 17 September.**

About the Festival:

This autumn the London Borough of Lewisham is to play host to a brand new cultural festival centred on the subject of ageing and creative approaches to

the issue of growing old. Age Against the Machine – Festival of Creative Ageing will take place 13 September – 6 October 2019 in venues and outdoor spaces throughout the Borough. The Albany and Entelechy Arts are the festival's lead producers.
